MILWAUKEE.- Smithsonian magazine's April issue names the Milwaukee Art Museum one of "Seven Special Places to Visit This Summer" in its Destination America feature. The Museum is called a "shore bird" and "an urban landmark." Other locations include Little Bighorn in Montana and Pennekamp State Park in Florida. Smithsonian magazine has a readership of more than 7 million.

The Washington Post's Sunday, March 27 travel section features Milwaukee and the Milwaukee Art Museum.
