

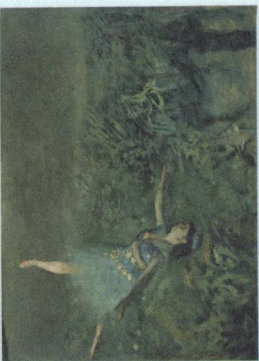

Degas Sculptures presents a rare opportunity to view all 73 bronze sculptures by the great French Impressionist master, Edgar Degas. In addition to the sculptures, a number of related paintings, pastels and drawings are included. Featured among Degas' celebrated bathers, horses and dancers in *Degas Sculptures* is one of the icons of 19th-century art, *Little Dancer, Aged Fourteen*. This masterpiece was the only sculpture Degas exhibited in his lifetime. The Milwaukee Art Museum is the only Midwest venue for this spectacular exhibition.
